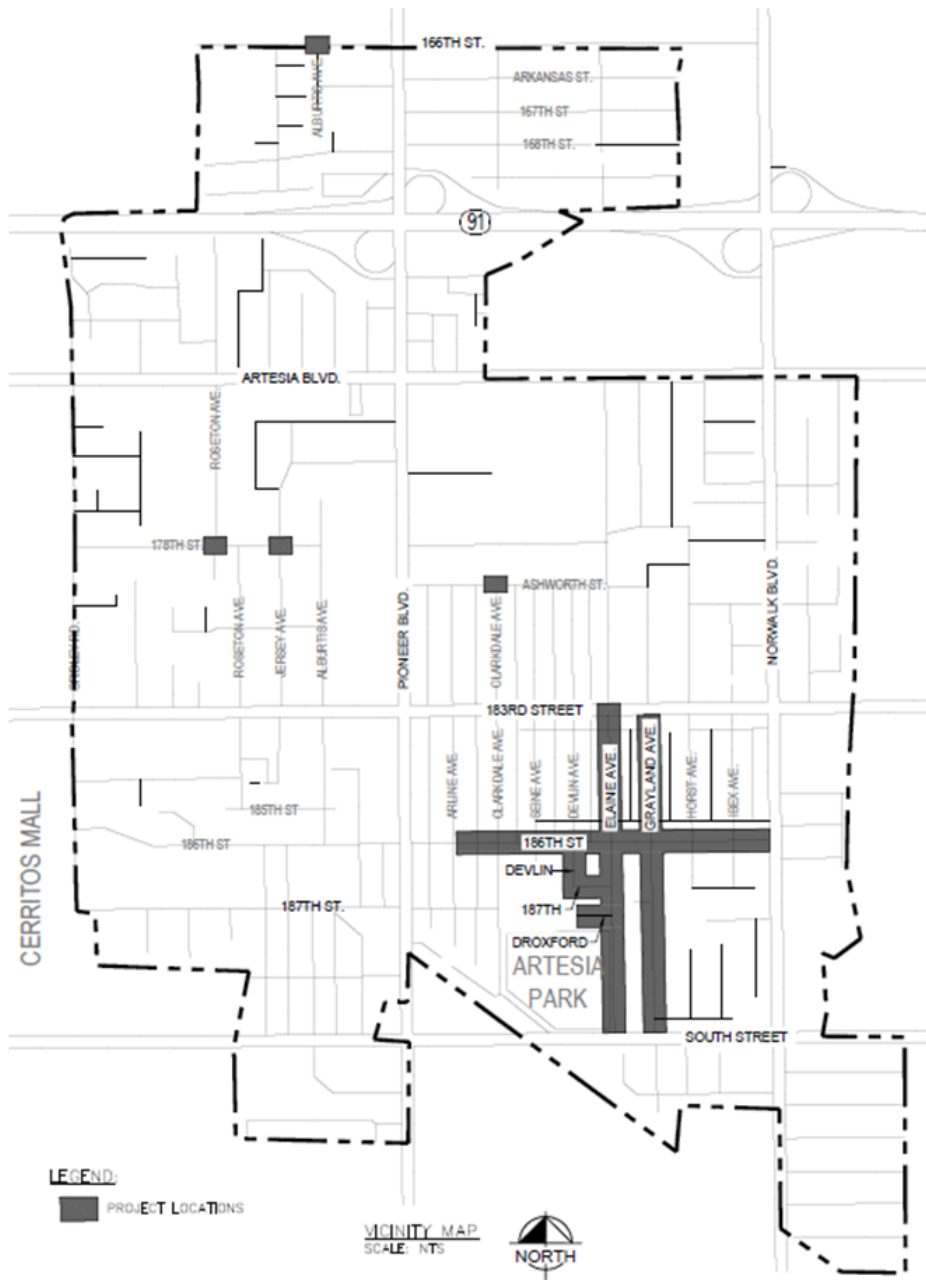

RECOMMENDATION:

Staff Recommends that the Public Works Committee recommend to the City Council:

1. Approval of the Highway Safety Improvement Program and Traffic Calming Street Improvement Project Plans; and
2. Award of a Construction Contact to the lowest responsive bidder to Implement the Highway Safety Improvement Program and Traffic Calming Street Improvement Project.

BACKGROUND:



- 1. Road: Elaine Avenue
- Segments: 183rd Street to South Street
- Road Condition: Satisfactory

Proposed Road Improvements: (1) Seal cracks and install slurry seal; (2) Remove top 2-inches of asphalt surface, and repave with 2-inch rubberized asphalt surface at select locations; (3) Remove buried longitudinal concrete gutter at the intersection of 187th Street and install full asphalt pavement section; and (4) Install new ADA compliant curb ramps and/or truncated domes at the intersection of Droxford Street for the mid-block crosswalk.

Proposed Traffic Calming Improvements: (1) Install enhanced crosswalks at the intersections of 183rd Street, 186th Street, 187th Street, and Droxford Street; (2) Install enhanced mid-block crosswalk at the intersection of Droxford Street; (3) Install red curb at intersections and crosswalks in accordance with Assembly Bill 413; (4) Install edgeline and centerline striping for visual narrowing; and (5) Install applicable pavement markings and street signage.

2. Road: Grayland Avenue
- Segments: 183rd Street to South Street
- Road Condition: Very Poor to Serious

Proposed Road Improvements: (1) Removal of the top 2-inches of asphalt surface, and repave with 2-inch rubberized asphalt surface; (2) Install a mid-block raised crosswalk with improvements to adjacent sidewalk; and (3) Install new ADA compliant curb ramps and/or truncated domes at the intersection of 186th Street.

Proposed Traffic Calming Improvements: (1) Install enhanced crosswalks at the intersections of 186th Street and South Street; (2) Install enhanced crosswalk including Rapid Flashing Beacon at mid-block crosswalk; (3) Install red curb at intersections and crosswalks in accordance with Assembly Bill 413; (4) Install centerline striping for visual narrowing; and (5) Install applicable pavement markings and street signage.

3. Road: 186th Street
- Segments: Arline Avenue to the Norwalk Boulevard
- Road Condition: Satisfactory to Very Poor

Proposed Road Improvements: (1) Removal of the top 2-inches of asphalt surface, and repave with 2-inch rubberized asphalt surface; (2) Seal cracks and install slurry seal at select locations; and (3) Install new ADA compliant curb ramps and/or truncated domes at intersections of Clarkdale Avenue, Devlin Avenue, Elaine Avenue, Grayland Avenue, and Horst Avenue.

Proposed Traffic Calming Improvements: (1) Install enhanced crosswalks at the intersections of Clarkdale Avenue, Devlin Avenue, Elaine Avenue, Horst Avenue, and Norwalk Boulevard; (2) Install Rapid Flashing Beacon at Devlin Avenue; (3) Install miniature roundabouts at the intersections of Clarkdale Avenue and Elaine Avenue; (4) Install red curb at intersections in accordance with Assembly Bill 413; (5) Install applicable pavement markings and street signage.

4. Road: Devlin Avenue
- Segment: 186th Street to 187th Street
- Road Condition: Satisfactory

Proposed Road Improvements: (1) Seal cracks and install slurry seal; and (2) Install new ADA compliant curb ramps and/or truncated domes at intersection of 186th Street.

5. Road: 187th Street
- Segment: Devlin Avenue to Elaine Avenue
- Road Condition: Satisfactory

Proposed Road Improvements: (1) Seal cracks and install slurry seal; and (2) Removal of the top 2-inches of asphalt surface, and repave with 2-inch rubberized asphalt surface at intersection with Elaine Avenue.

6. Road: Droxford Street
Segment: Cul-de-Sac to Elaine Avenue
Road Condition: Serious

Proposed Road Improvements: (1) Removal of the top 2-inches of asphalt surface, and repave with 2-inch rubberized asphalt surface.

7. Intersection: 166th Street and Alburdis Avenue

Proposed Road Improvements: (1) Install new ADA compliant curb ramps and/or truncated domes including improvements to adjacent sidewalks.

Proposed Traffic Calming Improvements: (1) Install enhanced crosswalk along 166th Street; (2) Install red curb at intersections and crosswalks in accordance with Assembly Bill 413; and (3) Install applicable pavement markings.

8. Intersection: 178th Street and Roseton Avenue

Proposed Road Improvements: (1) Install new ADA compliant truncated domes on existing curb ramps.

Proposed Traffic Calming Improvements: (1) Install enhanced crosswalk; (2) Install red curb at intersections in accordance with Assembly Bill 413; and (3) Install applicable pavement markings.

9. Intersection: 178th Street and Jersey Avenue

Proposed Road Improvements: (1) Install new ADA compliant truncated domes on existing curb ramps.

Proposed Traffic Calming Improvements: (1) Install enhanced crosswalk at 4-way intersection; (2) Install red curb at intersections in accordance with Assembly Bill 413; and (3) Install applicable pavement markings.

10. Intersection: Clarkdale Avenue and Ashworth Street

Proposed Road Improvements: (1) Install new ADA compliant truncated domes on existing curb ramps.

Proposed Traffic Calming Improvements: (1) Install enhanced crosswalk along Ashworth Street; and (2) Install applicable pavement markings and street signage.

ANALYSIS:

The proposed Project is a “public project” as defined in Artesia Municipal Code Section 3-4.19(b)(2)(A). The City has adopted the Uniform Public Construction Cost Accounting Act (“UPCCAA”) (Pub. Contract Code, § 22000, *et seq.*), which governs the City’s award of public projects. Public projects valued above \$200,000 must use formal bidding procedures in accordance with the Artesia Municipal Code and California Contracting Code. The City received a total of eight (8) sealed bids for the Project:
