5.A. 2026 Legislative Session Update - 6:27 PM

Councilmember Henkel moved to take an oppose unless amended position on HB26-1001: Housing Developments on Qualifying Property. The motion was seconded by Councilmember Cohen, and passed 7-2. Councilmember Ward and Councilmember Delgadillo opposed.

Mayor Pro Tem Lim moved to take an amend position on SB26-040: Affordable Home Ownership Program. The motion was seconded by Councilmember Anderson, and passed 9-0.

Councilmember Anderson moved to take an oppose position on SB26-070: Ban Government Access Historical Location Information Database. The motion was seconded by Councilmember Henkel, and failed 4-5. Councilmember Cohen, Councilmember Braun, Councilmember Ward, Councilmember Delgadillo, and Councilmember Twiss opposed.

Mayor Castriotta moved to take an oppose position on HB26-1114: Allowed Minimum Lot Size for Subject Jurisdictions. The motion was seconded by Councilmember Cohen, and passed 6-3. Councilmember Ward, Councilmember Delgadillo, and Councilmember Twiss opposed.

Councilmember Cohen moved to take an oppose position on SB26-024: State & Local Unmanned Aircraft Regulation. The motion was seconded by Councilmember Anderson, and passed 9-0.

Mayor Pro Tem Lim moved to approve on second reading and order published by title Ordinance No. 2293 amending Chapter 10-12 of the Municipal Code Relating to Oversized and Commercial Vehicles. The motion was seconded by Councilmember Delgadillo.

Councilmember McKenzie moved to introduce an amendment, for the administration of a seven (7) day visitor permit, and approve on second reading. The motion was seconded by Councilmember Cohen, and passed 9-0.

Councilmember McKenzie moved to introduce a second amendment, for administration of a temporary compliance permit. The motion was seconded by Councilmember Ward.

Mayor Pro Tem Lim moved to table Councilmember McKenzie's second amendment, for administration of a temporary compliance permit, until a third reading to be scheduled for a date certain. The motion was seconded by Councilmember Henkel, and passed 9-0.

Councilmember McKenzie moved to introduce a third amendment, to mandate humanitarian outreach. The motion was seconded by Councilmember Ward, and passed 9-0.

Mayor Pro Tem Lim moved to approve as amended, order published in full, and schedule for a third reading Ordinance No. 2293 amending Chapter 10-12 of the Municipal Code Relating to Oversized and Commercial Vehicles. The motion was seconded by Councilmember Delgadillo, and passed 9-0.

7.B. Public Hearing - Ordinance Second Reading - Amending Chapter 12-08 of the Municipal Code Relating to Encroachments in Broomfield- 9:37 PM

Councilmember Ward moved to approve on first reading and order published in full Ordinance 2296 amending the municipal code to prohibit discrimination within Broomfield in housing, employment, and public accommodations. The motion was seconded by Councilmember Twiss, and passed 9-0.
