Public Hearing was opened at 6:31 PM and closed at 7:54 PM

Councilmember Cohen moved to approve Resolution No. 2026-35 Approving North Park Filing No. 7 Replat A Final Plat, Site Development Plan and Master Sign Plan. Councilmember McKenzie seconded the motion, which passed 10-0.

7.B. Public Hearing - Ordinance Third Reading - Amending Chapter 10-12 of the Municipal Code Relating to Oversized and Commercial Vehicles- 8:10 PM

Public Hearing was opened at 8:14 PM and closed at 8:58 PM

Councilmember Ward moved to approve Ordinance No. 2293 Amending Chapter 10-12 Oversized and Commercial Vehicles, as already amended, on third and final reading. The motion was seconded by Mayor Pro Tem Lim.

Councilmember McKenzie moved to remove from the table the "temporary compliance permit" or "Green Pass" amendment. The motion was seconded by Councilmember Delgadillo and failed 7-2. Councilmembers McKenzie and Delgadillo voted yes. Councilmember Henkel was absent.

The original motion to approve Ordinance No. 2293 as already amended passed 7-2. Councilmembers Peterson and Twiss voted no. Councilmember Henkel was absent.

Councilmember Ward moved to approve Ordinance No. 2284 Updating the Broomfield Municipal Code General Penalty Provision. Councilmember Delgadillo seconded the motion, which passed 9-0. Councilmember Henkel was absent.

Councilmember Delgadillo moved to approve Ordinance No. 2299 Updating the Broomfield Municipal Code Provisions for Shoplifting, Theft and Defraud by Check to Align Penalties with Colorado State Law Based on Dollar Amounts. Councilmember Ward seconded the motion, which passed 9-0. Councilmember Henkel was absent.

7.D. Public Hearing - Ordinance Second Reading - Addition of a Municipal Code Chapter Prohibiting Discrimination Within Broomfield- 10:20 PM

Public Hearing was opened at 10:20 PM and closed at 10:26 PM

Councilmember Ward moved to approve Ordinance No. 2296 Amending the Municipal Code to Prohibit Discrimination in Housing, Employment, and Public Accommodations Within Broomfield. Councilmember Delgadillo seconded the motion, which passed 9-0. Councilmember Henkel was absent.


7.E. Resolution - Construction Agreement with Diamond Contracting for the 2026 Waterline Replacement Project- 10:27 PM
