### Minutes

1. Call to Order The meeting was called to order by the Chair Ms. Beach at 6:35 p.m.
2. Roll Call and Excused Absences – Members Present: Ms. Beach, Ms. Tudyk, Ms. Draughon, Mr. Armstrong and Ms. Rose; Members Absent: Mr. McDaniel. Ms. Draughon made the motion to excuse the absence of Mr. McDaniel. The motion was seconded by Mr. Armstrong. For: All; Against: None. The motion carried 5 to 0.
3. Moment of Silence/Invocation – Ms. Beach called for a Moment of Silence.
4. Pledge of Allegiance – All in attendance recited the Pledge of Allegiance.
5. Citizens to be Heard  
This is the only time during the Historic Meeting that a citizen can address the Historic Committee. It is the opportunity for visitors and guests to address the Committee on any issue to include agenda items. All visitors wishing to speak must fill out the Sign-In Roster prior to the start of the meeting. Historic Committee may not debate any non-agenda issue, nor may any action be taken on any non-agenda issue at this time; however, the Committee may present any factual response to items brought up by citizens. (Attorney General Opinion - JC-0169) (Limit of three minutes each.) All remarks shall be addressed to the Committee as a body. Remarks may also be addressed to any individual member of the Committee so long as the remarks are (i) about matters of local public concern and (ii) not disruptive to the meeting or threatening to the member or any attendee, including City staff. Any person violating this policy may be requested to leave the meeting, but no person may be requested to leave or forced to leave the meeting because of the viewpoint expressed. **This meeting is livestreamed. 7. Discussion / Action
  - A. Discussion/Action on Historic Committee activities for 2026.  
  
Painting the mural and pots were discussed. Ms. Beach gave some information on estimate cost. Ms. Beach and Ms. Tudyk also spoke on what they presented to City Council on this project. Everyone seem to be in favor of

continuing with this project. Next step will be to put together an actual cost of what each project will cost. This is required to get the funds to proceed with the project. Ms. Beach also spoke on the flags and was able to give a rough cost of how much the flags would cost. The committee talked about the distance between the flags as this will make a difference on the amount of flags ordered. Flags would be from Main Street and FM 78 to HEB. Flags would be on both sides of the street. The committee will get permission from homeowners if they have to put flags on personal property. Flags will be put up in the morning on July 4<sup>th</sup> and taken down that evening. Flags will be kept so they can be reused the following year. Mr. Armstrong will check to see if the Rotary Club Young Group would be interested in helping with this event. Ms. Rose will check with the Lions Club Leo Group to see if they are interested in helping. Ms. Beach will work on a cost check to present to council at the March meeting so they can get the flags ordered. The History Committee did feel that the Cemetery Walk that was done by the Historic Committee would be a project they were willing to do this coming year. There ~~was~~<sup>were</sup> not many people that attended the event and since it's a private cemetery they decided not to proceed with this project. Ms. Draughon did bring up the ideal of the Cibolo Cookbook. The committee did have a conversation on this, and it will be brought again at future meetings.
