7. Discussion / Action

A. Discussion/Action on Historic Committee activities for FY 24-25 and FY 25-26.

The group talked about the painting of the flowerpots. They decided to paint the eight pots that are out by the Multi-Event Center. The paint required to paint the pots was discussed. Two of the members checked prices. The group decided that they would need to have three gallons of paint which would cost \$105.00. When reporting to the City Council in December they will also explain what type of design they would be placing on the pots. The mural that they plan on paint on the backside of the mural on Main Street would also require paint and supplies. Ms. Beach will have a design to explain to City Council what would be painted with the help of the School Art Club. The second project the group will present to City Council is the placing of the flags on Main Street from the bowling alley to city hall for the Fourth of July this coming year. They have priced the cost of flags which will be 12 by 18 with a 30in dowel. To place flags on both side of the street would cost approximately \$600.00. The flags would be put up early Saturday, July 4th and kept up over the weekend. The group would pick up the flags so they can be reused the following year. Also mention was the ability for the group to use the back of the Map Boards that are on Main Street (City Parking area and Mural area). The Historic Committee would place the information on the History of Cibolo (Building or Family). Both Ms. Tudyk and Ms. Beach will be presenting these items to City Council on December 9th.
