A. Discussion/Action on Historic Committee activities for FY 24-25 and FY 25-26.

Ms. Beach and Ms. Tudyk informed the group that they did present to the City Council on December 9th the three project that the Historic Committee wish to take on this coming year. The projects presented were the Flags on Main St. (Old Town Area), back side of the mural on Main St., and the flowerpots near the Multi-Event area. Flags – We presented to council that we would like to place flags in the Old Town Area (Main St from FM 78 to the Bowling Alley). Council seem to be in favor of this project. There were a couple members that wanted the flags all the way down Main St and Cibolo Valley Drive. Council did ask to come back with a written cost proposal for the event. Flowerpots – We briefed what we had in mind for this project and did pass out the designs. Council seem to like the designs. We did get ask why the pots by the Multi-Event Center instead of by the mural. Council was explained that we wanted to make sure that the paint and coating would actually work on the pots and those pots would be a better group to test the paint and design. Council would like a cost proposal for the project. Mural (back Side) – Council seem to like the design where the painters would fill in the letters of CIBOLO with different design showcasing Cibolo. They would like to see if those painting the mural could be opened up to other in the community to include homeschool children.
