## NEW BUSINESS

Consider **Ordinance No. 2026-025** providing for the issuance and sale of City of Grapevine, Texas Combination Tax and Revenue Certificates of Obligation, Series 2026 in an aggregate principal amount not to exceed \$30,000,000; awarding the sale thereof; levying a tax in payment thereof; authorizing the execution and delivery of a paying agent/registrar agreement; approving the official statement; approving a bond counsel engagement letter, and enacting other provisions relating thereto.

11. Consider the renewal of an annual sole source contract for public safety radio maintenance with the City of Bedford. Police Chief and Fire Chief recommends approval.
12. Consider the renewal of an annual contract for the purchase of grounds maintenance equipment, irrigation parts, supplies and installations from Longhorn, Inc. Director of Parks and Recreation and Director of Public Works recommend approval.
13. Consider the payment of the Grapevine Lake operation and maintenance fee to the US Army Corps of Engineers. Director of Public Works recommends approval.
