A. CALL TO ORDER AND ROLL CALL

Chairperson Miller called the meeting to order at 6:30 pm in the City Hall Council Chambers, located at 14717 Burin Avenue, Lawndale, CA 90260.

B. FLAG SALUTE

Commissioner Owens led the flag salute.

C. APPROVAL OF MINUTES

1. Approval of the Minutes from the October 27, 2025, Commission Meeting

A motion was made by Commissioner Owens and seconded by Chairperson Miller to approve the October 27, 2025, minutes as written.

Motion carried 3-0, with Commissioners Castro and Collins absent.

D. PRESENTATIONS

2. Tommy Ton and John Yernessian with El Camino College. Mr. Ton and Mr. Yernessian shared a few slides and talked about current opportunities at El Camino, including new programs and options for students, and highlighted the Real Estate Program. There were a few questions from Commissioners, including a request for updates at future meetings.

E. ORAL COMMUNICATIONS – Items not on the agenda (Public Comments)

George Wassil, baseball coach at Environmental Charter High School, provided a handout and talked about the condition of the fields at Anderson Elementary School, including access to water and the addition of clay/brick dust.

F. COMMENTS FROM COMMISSIONERS

Vice Chairperson Wood – Talked about the Halloween event and how busy the commission booth was, including running out of bags; she also mentioned all the senior citizens in costume;

Commissioner Owens – Mentioned connections with El Camino college.

Chairperson Miller – Talked about the fields at Rogers/Anderson and asked if staff could work with ECHS to try to improve some of the areas of concern addressed by Mr. Wassil; also mentioned that he'd like to help if he can;

G. ADMINISTRATIVE MATTERS

3. Lawndale Beat Ridership Report – October 2025;

Director Minter briefly discussed the staff report, and introduced Brett Baum with Transportation Concepts. Brett spoke a little about his role with Transportation Concepts, and provided brief updates on the busses. There was a brief discussion with the Commissioners, before Vice Chairperson Wood made a motion to approve the minutes, noting that the agenda showed the August minutes listed. Staff acknowledged the error as a scriveners' error. A second was made by Commissioner Owens.

Motion carried 3-0, with Commissioners Castro and Collins absent.

4. Halloween Haunt Review

Director Minter summarized his thoughts on the event, along with areas that were better and potential options for future events. The Commissioners then shared their thoughts:

Commissioner Owens mentioned that she'd be interested in having the City Council recognize the students from ECCH; she asked if this was the first Haunted Maze; she said Corner Burger was very crowded; she asked about having one central place for candy; and expressed concerns over giving everyone a bag;

Chairperson Miller liked the bags, but thought the work that went into the glo necklaces was more than expected; wants the PRSSC to recognize the student volunteers with certificates;

Vice Chairperson Wood wanted to be sure to order more bags in the future;

5. Director's Report

Director Minter provided updates on the following topics:

- Introduced Program Coordinator Darrion Spratley, and invited Darrion to introduce himself and talk about the programs he was responsible for and things that were happening in the Department.
- Reminded the commissioners of the dark nights in November and December.
- A request to recognize students from Environmental Charter High School for their volunteerism in planning for the Department's Halloween Haunt, specifically the Haunted Maze. After some discussion about commission and council meetings, the Commission agreed to offer to recognize the students at the next Commission meeting on December 8, 2015.
- Director Minter reminded the Commissioners that their approved day to volunteer is Tuesday, December 9, at approximately 5:30 pm. If enough commissioners are not available, members of the Senior Citizen Advisory Committee will be invited to assist as well.

RE: Recognition of Students at Environmental Charter High School

Staff in the Community Services Department often work with organizations and members of the community to increase the service level that is provided to the community. Recently, in preparation for the 2025 Halloween Haunt, the Community Services Department reached out to representatives from the Environmental Charter High School (ECHS) here in Lawndale to work on a pilot project that allows the students to volunteer for City programs as a way of getting their volunteer hours while also learning about the Community Services Department and getting hands on experience planning and preparing for large community events.

Early in October, department staff began meeting with a small group of students from ECHS to plan for the Haunted Maze, one of the more difficult tasks that face staff during the planning and preparation for the Halloween Haunt event. These students included the following:

The planning process began with a summary of the goals of the maze, including a tour of the room, a look at the equipment, and a brainstorming session for themes that could be used in the Haunted Maze. The students did not disappoint, and soon there were numerous options discussed and ultimately voted on by the students. And with their theme in hand they were off and running. Staff from the Department assisted in the areas of procurement, construction, and lighting, but the students played an instrumental role in creating the story behind the theme, and helping bring it to life.

Staff recommend that the Parks, Recreation and Social Services Commission recognize these student volunteers for their outstanding effort and commitment in assisting the Lawndale Community Services Department plan and prepare for the 2025 Halloween Haunt Maze.
