A. CALL TO ORDER AND ROLL CALL

B. FLAG SALUTE

Commissioner Castro led the flag salute.

C. APPROVAL OF MINUTES

1. Approval of the Minutes from the May 11, 2026, Commission Meeting

After a brief review a motion was made by Commissioner Owens to approve the minutes. The motion was seconded by Vice Chairperson Collins.

Motion carried 30, absent Commissioner Miller and Chairperson Wood.

3. Parks, Recreation and Social Services Trust Fund

Director Minter introduced the staff report and requested feedback from the Commissioners about the topic and whether or not it should be tabled until more Commissioners were in attendance at the meeting. After a few questions and comments from the Commissioners Vice Chairperson Collins agreed that it would be better to continue the discussion at the July meeting. The Commission agreed through unanimous consent to table the discussion until the July meeting.
