James Crippen discussed ILT traffic on Old Decatur. He said that prohibiting turns/u turns in front of school will not solve problem and will just move drivers down to the next turnaround. He said ILT has made improvements in past year, complaints have decreased, none during this fall startup.

3.B. Update on Traffic Safety Concerns on McLeroy Blvd at Willow Creek Elementary--Lt. James Crippen

Lt. James Crippen spoke about PD response to Willow Creek Elementary issue. They closed the center with barricades, posted public service information, and assigned two officers to monitor traffic at peak times, seemed to work pretty well to relieve problems. Overall, school startup there has been good.
